volving the courts, and jury system, saying:

"Taft is not an unbiased judge where a jury system is under consideration. He is not known as the father of government by injunction, but is prejudiced against the jury system. A long service upon the bench has led him to underrate the importance of the system. Taft has fallen into the error of assuming, any improvement in the method of court procedure, is an attack upon the authority of the court."

"One of the greatest problems of the day is to secure an equitable distribution of the proceeds of toil and material wealth. This country is largely one of joint products, where men work together. The army organization applies in some degree; some direct, and others are indirect. The labor question as it presents itself at this time, is chiefly a question of distribution. The legislation asked for will secure to each and all, services entitle them to, as legislation is secured through the ballot, everybody should use his ballot to obtain legislation. The democratic platform presents an ideal toward which the democratic party is striving, namely, justice in the distribution of rewards."
