COURT SAVES COUNTY \$463

WISE ACTION TAKEN BY COURT COMMENDABLE.

By Deciding to Build its Own Bridges the County Court Has Saved Neat Sum for Taxpayers—Lowest Bid for Union Bridge Was \$1026, While the County Builds it for \$563—More Money to Reduce Debt With.

The county court's decision to build its own bridges and divert from the the custom of the past in issuing advertisements for bids to build all county road bridges, has proven itself to be one of the many "wise moves" made by that body during its occupancy. In the completion of the new bridge across Catherine creek at Union the court has figured its savings, and it will be real pleasure to the taxpayers to know that in the first effort of the county to build its own bridges, it has secured a splendid structure, and what is almost of as great significance, is that \$463 were saved the taxpayers.

Enormous Saving Percentage.

This figure is immense, considering the size of the bids made when the advertisements were issued. The county court was forced to build the 40-foot bridge at Union and called for bids according to past custom. When the time came to let the contract, the court and supervisors adopted a new course. The lowest bid at that time for the Union bridge was \$1026. After 11 days of work, County Bridge Superintendent Campbell has completed the bridge. It stands as a model in workmanship, but the cost of building this bridge, declared by experts to be as good, if not better than any contracting company's product, is only \$563. This means a saving of \$463 over what it would have cost the county had it let the contract to other firms at the lowest bid offered.

Thus is supplied nearly \$500 more to reduce the county debt. The county court is to be complimented on its money-making scheme.

Superintendent Campbell has gone up the river today to repair the bridges on the Grande Ronde, which have been declared faulty.

In the other event two heats were won by Roy Oliver's black animal against Hiram Peach's buckskin, in 25 flat. Both sets of dashes were highly exciting.

Another race has been framed up for next Sunday afternoon between Dude Bull's horse and the Peach buckskin.

Aside from the horse races there was some genuine and clever bronco busting at the fair grounds yesterday. Roy Halley rode an especially vicious animal in a creditable manner, and remained seated until the animal had kicked himself out. The act is credited with being some of the best work seen here in several years.
