### MAY ABANDON BRIDGES

of money for the taxpayers by building their own bridges, the court is of the river to allow the construction of a county road where the river now now discussing the feasibility of doing away with two bridges across the Grande Ronde river on the east side of Perry, and changing the channel wends its way for a distance of about a quarter mile.

#### New Bridges Needed.

Any one who has been up the Grande Ronde river recently, knows the precarious condition of the rattle-trap structures that span the river in two instances, just below Perry.

It is absolutely necessary that new bridges be constructed in these two instances, and to reconstruct them would necessitate building steel structures as nothing else will withstand the spring floods. That means an outlay of \$2000 for each bridge, at least something must be done.

#### Discuss Novel Scheme.

Yesterday afternoon County Judge Henry and Bridge Superintendent Campbell visited the region. The county road follows the river on the north bank until it reaches the first of the twin bridges. It then crosses to the south side and for a distance of a quarter mile runs on that side, only to recross to the north side at Perry. Here it is that the county court and commissioners plan to save at least \$2000, for, instead of crossing the river twice, the river itself will be diverted about 100 feet, a small cove of rock worked down and the road continued along the north bank of the river. Everything is favorable for this scheme and preliminary estimates made as to the cost, place the figures between \$2000 and \$3000, less than half the cost of building two bridges of steel.

Throw from the rocky cliff and the old bridges can be used as bulkheads, and, in fact, natural conditions are such that a perpetual road, free from spring washouts, can be constructed at the cost named. As soon as Commissioner Ben Brown and Commissioner J. M. Seider can be brought into communication with the court, the matter will be given final action.

#### Locomotive Engineers.

Savannah, Ga., Sept. 15.—One of the largest gatherings of union labor ever held in the southeast marked the opening here today of the session of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and the ladies' auxiliary of that organization. Every state east of the Mississippi, and several states west of that river, are represented by delegates. In addition to business sessions, excursions will be run for the benefit of the visitors to Tybee Island and other points of interest in the vicinity of Savannah. Officials of the union state that it is in a prosperous condition and that there is every evidence that a season of renewed prosperity for all railroad employes is now beginning.

#### MARATHON RACE AT OAKLAND.

Patterned After Great Grecian Event—Will Attract Interest.

Oakland, Sept. 15.—The first Marathon race to be run in the west over a course is to be held in East Oakland hills Thanksgiving day, according to announcement today by the Century Athletic club in this city. It will be started at Fruitvale, over a mountain trail and through Joaquin Miller's home place. The course is to be about 23 miles.

#### A "Newsy" Killed.

San Jose, Cal., Sept. 14.—Clarence Mason, a newsboy, 14 years old, was instantly killed at the depot this morning while selling papers, by a Southern Pacific train. His head was completely severed.
