EXPERT FOR LOCAL PLANT

LOCAL INDUSTRY ABOUT TO GROW WITH LONG STRIDES.

Packing Plant Recently Completed on Outskirts of the City is Now in Charge of an Expert From Walla Walla—Railroad to Wallowa is a Feeder for Extensive Business for Local Plant—Mohr is an Expert in His Line.

An item of some interest in La Grande industrial circles is the arrival of W. P. Mohr in this city Sunday evening. Mr. Mohr has purchased stock in the Grande Ronde Meat company, and will take entire charge of the cold storage and packing plant recently completed near the city, which will give the other members of the firm an opportunity of caring for the increasing downtown and outside interests. Mr. Mohr was, up to a few days ago, a member of the big meat packing concern, the Walla Walla Meat company, for the past five years. While with that firm a cold storage plant was installed in the Garden City and under his skillful management he has seen the plant grow from the small beginning of killing five hogs a day until the capacity at present is over 2000 per month, due directly to the facilities for caring for the carcasses, such as the local firm has just installed.

With the branch O. R. & N. line being extended into Wallowa, one of the greatest hog-raising counties in the state, the prospects of this one phase of the packing industry is indeed flattering to the members of the local firm. Additional improvements are contemplated for the immediate future, and the plant enlarged from time to time as the needs of the business demand. Prior to becoming a member of the Walla Walla firm, Mr. Mohr spent seven years with a prominent coast packing plant in the same capacity he filled at Walla Walla and will now preside over the destinies of the local plant.

NEW TRAINS LATE.

Wallowa Schedule is Strenuous One and Trains May Often Be Late.

It appears that the branch line trains will assume that irregular schedule which characterized their runs on that road some time ago. The train from Wallowa last night was over an hour late, and the long run, with much freight business to retard the running schedule, will necessarily mean that the train due here at 6 o'clock will oftentimes be late.

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 24th day of November, 1908, a special election will be held of the voters of the City of La Grande, Union county, Oregon, and that the polls will be open from the hour of 8 o'clock a. m. until the hour of five o'clock p. m. of said day.

Said election is called by order of the Council of the City of La Grande for the purpose of proposing and submitting to the people of the City of La Grande the approval and adoption of certain amendments to the charter of the city of La Grande as shown by the proposed charter heretofore approved by the council of the City of La Grande by ordinance No. 392, Series 1908, and filed with, and in the office of the recorder of the city of La Grande, on the 10th day of September, 1908.

The approval of these amendments by the people of the city of La Grande will be submitted to the voters on the following proposition:

Shall the City of La Grande amend its charter and approve the amendments to the city charter, and the new city charter proposed and submitted by the council to the people of the city of La Grande?

Fourth Ward, Harris' Hall—Judges: Bernard Logsdon, G. E. Fowler and John Sheak. Clerks: C. J. Vanderpool and Warren P. Noble.
