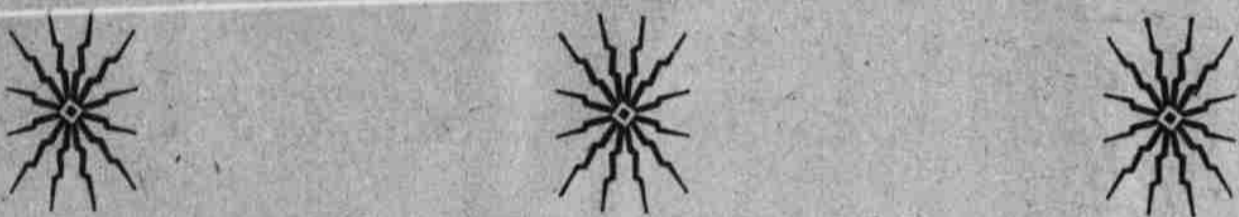

PLACE MEN SATURDAY

On net Saturday afternoon between 2 and 4 o'clock, the sugar company will place its employees in the day and night shifts, as the case may be, and final arrangements made for starting the factory on its continuous run until the beet crop is converted into sugar. The large force of men is handled with the strictest attention to detail, and, annually, a day or two before the factory starts, every applicant for a position in the factory, appears at the office and is listed or placed in one of the two shifts. This will be done on Saturday afternoon, and all applicants for positions should be on hand at that time.

What Factory Means.
 From a cash disbursement standpoint, the sugar factory means thousands to the county. While its annual payroll averages \$12,000 per month, the three months in which the factory is run, see the expenditure of about \$35,000. During the late winter months, the roll is reduced some, leaving a general average of \$12,000 for the entire year.
