Many prominent Italians from here and others are expected later. Senatore Tittoni, minister of foreign affairs, called the congress, which is under the auspices of the Italian government with the king as its honorary president. A large colonization scheme will be enosidered by the congress. It is proposed to acquire 25,000 acres or land in Texas or elsewhere and to send Italian immigrants there, equipped with utensils and supplied with cattie and seeds.

A few years ago all precincts in this part of the Willamette valley were the homes of many ring-necked pheasants, says the Brownsville Times. Today they are scarce, almost unto extinction. The scarcity is largely due to the slaughter of the splendid game birds by the city sportsmen during the first 10 days of open season.
