# FIRST MOVE FOR SPORTS

### TWO CLUBS WILL BE ORGANIZED HERE SOON.

Benefit Ball to Be Given in Rink Late in the Month to Aid Purchase of Uniforms for Baseball and Basketball Teams—By Commencing Early Teams Can Assume High Degree of Proficiency—Girls' Team Will Be Organized.

Looking toward the formation of indoor baseball and men's basketball teams in this city, with full practice possibilities and privileges in the Coliseum rink, a grand ball will be given at the rink October 31. Manager Jack O'Brien will attempt to get a large crowd to attend, that the sufficient money to purchase uniforms for both teams may be rounded up. Basketball and indoor baseball will be the only athletic attractions this season and the interest worked up in both men's and girls' basketball last year will also be revived and followers of the winter sport given attractions of a high class. Heretofore there has never been anything but half-hearted practice and training by the boys' teams, but if by starting in practice early in November, the team assumes a considerable degree of efficiency and can cope with other fast teams of the eastern portion of the state, that it is foreordained that financial support will be given. La Grande is liberal with its support, as a rule, where the class of exhibits warrants it.
