Agricultural and Fruit Fair Opens at Elgin tomorrow—Exhibits Now in Place at Masonic Hall—Will Last Two Days—Musical Attractions Will Enliven Occasion.

Elgin, Oct. 15.—(Special.)—The first annual agricultural fair to be held in Elgin opens tomorrow, and there is every prospect for a splendid attendance. The Masonic hall has been converted into a bower of sweet-smelling fruits and attractive agricultural products. The fair will continue for two days with many special features to draw crowds. Each evening there will be a public ball. During the day time there will be musical attractions at the headquarters in the nature of solos and instrumental renditions.

The exhibits are already in place and the promoters are highly pleased with the prospects for a successful fair. Nothing will have been left undone by tomorrow morning and with favorable weather, the opening day is expected to find visitors from every section of the valley. The Commercial club at Elgin extends a hearty welcome to all to attend this initial attempt at a local agricultural and fruit fair.

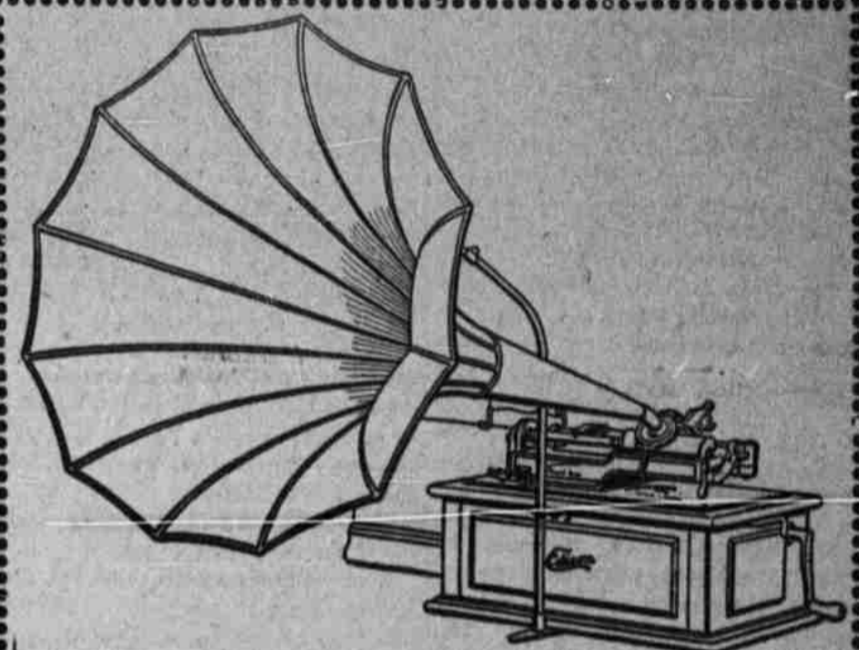
