BALLOTS ON THEIR WAY

Ballot boxes and ballots for the presidential election next Tuesday are being sent to the outlying precincts by the county clerk.

The precincts nearer the county capital will not be visited until a later date. The ballots are about one-eighth as large as the ballots of the primary election and voting will be comparatively easy. Oregon is one of two states in the union that does not vote on some state or national legislative candidate.

For this reason, the ballots to be voted on next Tuesday in La Grande are exclusively of presidential candidates only.
