### THE DIVORCE AN ISSUE.

Next Tuesday May Make a New and More Favorable Divorce Law.

Sioux Falls, S. D., Oct. 30.—Whether South Dakota will retain its reputation as the commonwealth where divorces are granted "while you wait," is one of the issues to be decided in the election in this state next Tuesday. On one side is ranged the lawyers, the hotel keepers, and a great many business men who believe that the divorce industry should be maintained and nourished as one of the material assets of the state's prosperity; opposed to these are thousands of farmers, clergymen and business men who believe that the present divorce law is a disgrace to the state and that it should be wiped out and a more stringent statute substituted. The battle is waging merrily, and in the meantime, the members of the Sioux Falls divorce colony who have not yet received the magic pieces of paper that spell liberty from matrimonial infelicities are occupying the anxious seat. Present appearances indicate that the new law will receive a sufficient number of votes to make it effective.

The present law requires only six months' residence in order to become a citizen of the state, and permits the holding of hearings in divorce cases in chambers, which tend to make many of them of the "star chamber" variety. This enables divorce applicants of prominence practically to secure secret divorces by preventing the particulars of the hearings, or even the fact that a divorce decree has been granted in a particular case.

The new divorce law, which will be referred to the voters at the election next Tuesday raises the period of residence from six months to one year, and requires that all divorce actions shall be heard in open court instead of "in chambers," as has been the practice in numerous instances under the present law.
