Odds Favor Hughes and Taft.
New York, Nov. 3.—Betting was active this morning. It is estimated that before noon \$300,000 were wagered. Odds favor Taft at 5 and 8 to 1. Most of the money on the state contest shows odds slightly in favor of Gov. Hughes' re-election.

Scratching in Ohio.
Cincinnati, O., Nov. 3.—Senator Foraker got considerable satisfaction out of voting today. He voted early and was in the booth a long time, evidently scratching.

Columbus, O., Nov. 3.—Scratching is the feature of the Ohio election. Voters are taking so long that it is doubtful whether the entire registration will be handled.

DYNAMITE FIRES FOUR BUILDINGS

PORT ORCHARD BLAZE COSTS TOWN 35,000 DOLLARS

Seattle, Nov. 3.—That a loss of \$35,000 in the burning of four stores in Port Orchard, was the result of dynamiting the safe in the Noyes grocery store last night by burglars, is the statement made by detectives today. Shortly before midnight an explosion was heard and a few minutes later a fire was discovered. Before the firemen arrived four buildings were gutted.
