## APPLE CROP IS ENORMOUS

Walla Walla, Nov. 10.—The total cash value of the fruit crop of the Walla Walla valley for the season will amount, in round numbers to \$1,000,000. This fact is assured by a recent estimate of the amount of fruit which has been shipped from the territory since the opening of the strawberry season, about June 1.

Up until the first of November, the number of cars of fruits and vegetables exported from this valley, totaled \$19 since June 1. Although there were a number of shipments of vegetables made before that time, these have not been included in the estimate given here. The majority of shipments have been prunes and apples, although several large lots of mixed commodities have been sent out.

It is estimated that at least \$1000 of the value of a car of fruit goes to the grower, any profits being received above this figure generally going to the commission or retail men. Figuring on this basis, \$829,000 have been received already by the growers for their products this season. Possibly a few of the cars included in this number did not bring the estimated \$1000, but wherever there was one which did not bring the \$1000, there were two which brought more than that.

Included in these figures are all the fruit shipments from the famous Free-water-Milton country, and also from the State Line and Dixie Dayton territory. Although the season is practically closed in the fruit line, in the way of gathering, it is likely that 40 or 50 cars are yet to be sent out from this valley to eastern points.
