ELLIS LOYAL T O CANNON

IS STRONGER FOR THE WEST THAN FOR CANNON.

Pendleton Solon Will Give Cannon His Vote, But Interview Indicates He's West Than for the Speaker.

"I will most certainly support Speaker Cannon for that office again if he is the nominee of the party caucus," declared Judge Ellis Tuesday morning, while discussing congressional affairs with the Pendleton East Oregonian. "Personally, Speaker Cannon and myself are good friends, and he has shown me every courtesy during his term as presiding officer in the house. I believe he is the best qualified of any man so far mentioned in connection with that office, but I would not definitely say just what I will do until I know exactly who will be presented as candidates.

"I can see no reason why a fight should be made on Speaker Cannon as being autocratic in his control of the house. I have served under Speaker Reed and Speaker Crisp, and he is not one bit more of a czar than were they."

Congressman Ellis expects to leave about the 3th for Washington, and immediately upon his arrival in the capital will urge two matters in which Pendleton is deeply interested: the construction of the new postoffice, and the establishment of an experiment farm in the Hermiston district.

"I shall see Secretary Wilson at once," said Judge Ellis, "and urge the immediate need for the experiment station in the west end. I am convinced that it will prove of enormous benefit to the settlers in that untried country. I shall urge that the department accept the ground set aside for the department farm and proceed at once to equip it. If funds are lacking I shall work in conjunction with the other members of the Oregon delegation to secure them. We don't need an experiment station to teach us how to raise wheat in this country, but the settlers in that fruit district do need it and I will use every effort to get it for them.

"I shall also call upon the supervising architect and use what pressure is possible to hurry along the postoffice building. Of course, we have the appropriation and it is now held up over

the matter of a site. It may be that the department considers the price asked too high, when, according to its policy new bids may be asked, or the government may exercise the right of eminent domain and condemn the property."

"I understand that an attack is being made upon Speaker Cannon on the ground of a report that he will oppose all large appropriations for the Panama canal during the coming session, thus retarding the agricultural and commercial development of the west. I place absolutely no credence in the report, but, of course, if it should be so, the speaker will alienate his west—stronger than for Cannon."
