### HAVE GOOD ALARM SOON.

Fire Whistle Sent to Albina to Undergo Several Changes.

The fire whistle that will some day in the near future serve as a fire alarm in this city, has been returned to Albina for improvements and repairs. The inlet to the bell was too small, not sufficient steam could enter to make sufficient sound. The hole will be enlarged and a convenient lever attached to displace the valve screw. When it returns to La Grande with these repairs and changes it will be adequate in noise-making propensities. Division Foreman Watson affirms that the particular tone which the whistle possesses, can be heard a distance greater than a mere shrill tone. He is confident the alarm will be entirely satisfactory when the required changes are made.

At Walla Walla tomorrow night he will be the officiating minister at the wedding of Miss Harriet Ankeny, daughter of Senator Levy Ankeny, to Captain E. P. Pope, U. S. A. The wedding is to be the leading social function of Walla Walla this season.

### PROTECT BIG PILING.

Spontaneous Combustion Will Not Touch Huge Pileings Hereafter.

Spontaneous combustion will no longer damage the huge pileings on which is constructed the elevated track at the coal storage bins in the O. R. & N. yards. Workmen are today shoveling the coal that has heaped about the piling to a place sufficiently distant from the piling to permit the building of a framework that will protect them. In order to do this it was found necessary to build temporary standard gauge tracks for the accommodation of the movable pocket truck. Into this pocket the coal now about the piling will be shoveled and transported to other parts of the bin. The protection is to be of heavy timber that stands at an angle, touching the elevated tracks and reach the bottom of the bin a considerable distance from the base of the piling. Fires of a spontaneous character, have been frequent and the expensive pileings have suffered thereby.
