PRELIMINARY WORK NOW

Now that La Grande is assured a good water system, the voters are looking forward to the time that the construction of the line will commence. During the winter months, while it is impractical to bury pipe lines, the council will wrestle with the red tape of securing a right of way through the government reserves. This is not a stumbling block, but a matter where the desired results are assured, though the procedure of securing it will be synonymous with hard work. The pipe will lead through some private timber land. No trouble is anticipated from this quarter. Detailed plans will be made, a survey plat secured and bids for construction advertised during the winter months, that construction of the water pipes can be commenced as soon as the mountains are cleared of snow. La Grande will have a water system better than the most and as good as the best.
