DRY LAW ATTACKED

Pendleton, Nov. 30.—Three separate attacks upon local option in Malheur county were filed today with Major Lee Moorhouse, clerk of the supreme court, for hearing at the Malheur court in this city.

In each case the action is based upon a city charter, passed since the prohibition act of 1904, which provides for city regulation of the liquor traffic. Two cases are from the town of Vale, the third is from Westfall. Both city charters were granted in February, 1905.

The suits are entitled respectively, J. H. Hart, plaintiff and appellant, James Haven and L. B. Teier, plaintiffs and appellants, and Floyd Garrison, plaintiff and appellant, vs. the County Court of Malheur county, B. C. Richardson, Judge, and W. J. Scott and G. B. Glover, commissioners, defendant in each instance.

The first entitled cause is from Westfall, the others from Vale, and in each G. W. Hayes represents the appellant and J. W. McCulloch the state.
