## WHY GIRLS LEAVE HOME

Manager Steward will present at the Steward on Wednesday, December 2, E. J. Carpenter's production of Fred Summerfield's emotional melodrama, "Why Girls Leave Home." It is said the title does not indicate the full value of the play. It is a melodrama which does not depend upon red fire or burning powder to give it interest, and it does not resort to mechanical contrivances, although it is effectively mounted. Besides furnishing a wholesome evening's entertainment, the play inculcates a valuable lesson, to-wit: that for girls at least the poet's advice is sound and it is better to bear the ills we have than fly to others we know not of. The plot hinges on the experiences of a young girl who is induced to leave a rather restricted home life by a designing villain and lives to regret her hasty step. The process by which she learns her lesson is more



salutary than pleasant. Pearl Sherwood is a pure-minded girl in a family near New York and she responds when the dazzling lights of the great city invite her to come and participate in its follies. There is a scene in a wine-room where a good deal of roguery is developed, and where Pearl Sherwood, discovering the true character of her associates, throws wine in the face of those who connive against her and flees from the path she is following. From that time until the knavery is overtaken there is excitement of various sorts. She is abducted, held prisoner, is the victim of a scheming woman and a man who is thoroughly bad, but in the end she escapes it all. The play is beautifully staged, the café and prison scenes being particularly effective.
