### STRIKE ARTESIAN WELL.

Blaock Farm at Walla Walla Worth Vast Sum of Money Today.

Walla Walla, Dec. 3.—At one drop of a huge drill at 9 o'clock last evening a cool million dollars was added to the value of the Blaock fruit ranch west of this city. At the same time untold value was added to the property of the entire Walla Walla valley. It was definitely settled last evening that the Walla Walla valley is underlaid by artesian water in sufficient quantities to probably irrigate the whole of it.

The drill that solved the problem has for the past week or more been driving and pounding at the bottom of the old well sunk some six years ago on the Blaock ranch just outside the military reservation, and at 9 o'clock last evening dropped through a strata of solid rock 20 feet in thickness. Immediately the water rushed up through the iron casing and rose in the air to a height of two feet. It was estimated by the man in charge of the drill at the time that when confined to a smaller nozzle the pressure would be 90 pounds to the square inch, but Manager A. J. Tourtelotte of the Blaock ranch thinks that probably 50 pounds will be nearer right. At any rate the fact was established that artesian water in gushing quantities can be had at any point west of the city by driving a well to a depth of 560 feet.
