GULLING TO PENDLETON.

Oldest Conductor on the Road Goes to Pendleton Next Sunday.

Seventeen years ago next January J. C. Gulling operated the construction train that built the Elgin railroad, and soon after ran the first train into the terminus. Today he made his last trip over the Elgin tracks, for next Sunday he goes to Pendleton to take the conductor's run on the Pilot Rock train, plying between Pendleton and Pilot Rock. The work there is not as arduous as the La Grande-Joseph run and more suited for Mr. Gulling's advanced age. He is the oldest conductor on the O. R. & N. in this section of the state, and the easiest job is due him. Mrs. Gulling will accompany him to Pendleton, where they will make their home as long as Mr. Gulling's health will permit him to work.
