NO. 6 DELAYED.

Slight Wreck Occurs in Railroad Yards This Morning.

Passenger train No. 6 was delayed in La Grande a half hour this morning on account of a slight wreck in the yards. Engine 381, pulling in a freight train, had just entered the east yard tracks, when its tank trucks were derailed on some unaccountable reason. In the course of half an hour, a switch engine had cleared the main line to allow No. 6 to pass, but it was nearly noon before the tank was finally run into the round house. An investigation is on to ascertain the cause of the derailment.

BRIDGE ABOUT FINISHED.

Some Riveting Yet to Do, But Big Bulk of Work is Done.

The new railroad bridge across the Grande Ronde river, just above Oro Dell, stands all but completed. There is yet much riveting to do, but the steel work is in place, and the approaches have been raised to coincide with the bridge rails, which are six inches higher than the old structure.
