M'ALLISTER BETTER.

Expert Examination Divulges Typhoid
 Fever Never Existed.

J. W. McAllister, who has been seriously ill for the past few weeks, is much improved and gives promise of gradual recovery. Owing to the disquieting rumors about his illness we secured from Dr. Moore, the osteopath, the following statement:

"I was called to Mr. McAllister a little over two weeks ago, and have directed his case with the greatest care. I have treated him according to my methods in such cases, and with excellent nursing care throughout, he is making very satisfactory improvement. For the past 24 hours his temperature has been practically normal. Mr. McAllister has no typhoid fever; he has not been sick with typhoid pneumonia. My diagnosis was a diseased condition of the liver, associated with gastro-intestinal disturbances and bronchial catarrh. I treated the disease but remittent fever will cover it with a name although the course was somewhat unusual.

"In order to appease the uncalled for anxiety of over-zealous friends as to diagnosis and methods employed, I have given the above statement and will further add that by Widal's reaction, a specimen of Mr. McAllister's blood was examined in the office of Dr. R. Matson, state bacteriologist, at Portland, with the result that the examination made was negative, showing there was no typhoid fever."

**CIVIL SUIT IS ON
 IN CIRCUIT COURT**

HUFFMAN JURY RETIRED AT
 10:30 THIS MORNING.

McCoy to be Sentenced Tomorrow—
 Civil Suit Now on Against Hooper &
 Hodson, Brought by National Bank
 of Elgin—Anderson Cases Set for
 Tomorrow.

The case of Hewett Bros., vs. G. L. Huffman, which has been holding the attention of the circuit court for the past two days, went to the jury about 10:30 this forenoon and up to press time have arrived at no decision.

The case on trial today in a civil action wherein J. B. Thorson, cashier of the Elgin National bank, is suing Hooper & Hodson in a matter growing out of an estate.

Raymond McCoy, who was early in the week convicted of burglary from a building, will receive his sentence tomorrow.

The Anderson whisky case is set for tomorrow.
