### BROUGHER WILL STAY IN OREGON, HE AFFIRMS

ON HIS WAY TO BOSTON, BUT WILL REFUSE OFFER.

While En Route to East, Portland Pastor of Great Fame, Decides to Refuse Big Offer.

Baker City, Dec. 23.—Dr. J. Whitcomb Brougher, pastor of the White Temple, Portland, and probably the best known minister in the northwest, passed through Baker City yesterday on his way to Boston, where he goes to consult with church officials relative to an offer made him to become pastor of Tremont Temple, the most influential Baptist church on the Atlantic coast. The offer carries with it a salary of \$10,000 a year.

It is understood when the doctor left Portland he was undecided as to whether he would accept, but by the time he reached Baker City he had made up his mind not to leave Oregon permanently, and will return as soon as he has conferred with the eastern Baptists.

He gave as his reason for not accepting what is believed to be one of the very best offers possible to make to any Baptist pastor, that the state of Oregon is developing so rapidly, and that there is so much to be done here, he is convinced that in the course of a few years he can make the White Temple in Portland occupy the same strong position on the Pacific coast that the Tremont temple in Boston occupies on the Atlantic.
