WANT A NEW 4-YEAR RULE

The organization of an athletic conference in eastern Oregon that will comprise every school that can claim an athletic team of any class, is meeting with much favor among the student element in this city. The athletes of the high school are anxious to have the conference draw up the eligibility rules this winter, that they may go into effect for the spring track and field meets.

Such a set of rules stringently enforced would have its effect here for the local school would lose Young, the high hurdler and pole vaulter, who has been one of the consistent point gainers for the La Grande high school during the past four years. But notwithstanding the loss, the students feel it is better to adopt the four-year rule than to allow a haphazard entrance to any athlete in the field meets and subsequently in football next fall.

13TH IN STATE

Union county must devote \$28,432.50 of its moneys toward the maintenance of the state expenses according to figures given out by the state board of tax levy last Saturday. The grand total which the taxpayers of Oregon are to raise for the coming year is \$1,680,697, of which amount \$1,275,000 will come from direct taxation and the balance from indirect sources. Twenty-one counties in the state received a lesser levy than Union, placing this county thirteenth in the state.
