



Joseph, Ore., Jan. J .- (Special.)-One of the highest price land deals consummated here for some time was completed Thursday, when George W. Boner, a Wallowa pioneer, sold his fine home ranch of 160 acres to F. H. Lanphear, late of Sherman county, for \$12,000. The farm is all improved land and lays in a cove a half mile west of Joseph, and a ditch direct com the mountains flows through the premises.

While the price is high, Mr. Boner hesitated to sell when the time came to finish the deal, and stated that he would not sell such a fine place did not his health render his retirement from active farm duties necessary.

Thus reads the first. In a year's time Wallowa county records will disclose that others of even great prices will have been consummated. The reason of all reasons why 160 acres of land in Wallowa county can bring \$12,000 is the railroad which at the close of last year linked Joseph and intermediate towns with the outside world. What the railroad has already done for Wallowa county, and what it will do to populate the heretofore secluded nook of Oregon, irrigation and electric lines will duplicate a hundredfold in Union county. Union is indisputably farther developed than its sister county, Wallowa, but it will require new developers in the former county if the latter is not to leap forward with strong bounds until she reaches and even passes the former. It is up to Union to secure irrigation and electric lines to keep in the lead of Wallown.
