AN IMPORTANT LETTER. The La Grande Investment Co. has received the following letter: Seattle, Nov. 24, 1908.

Robert Davis & Co., Green Lake, Wash. You appear on the policy register of the Pacific Fire Insurance company as holder of policy No. 1291, on which the annual premium is \$25.

This company has been unable to meet its obligations for losses upon policies issued by it, and by an order of the Superior court of the state of Washington for King county, in an action entitled W. deR. Rose vs. Pacific Fire Insurance company and number 62084 in the files of said court, a receiver for the property and assets of said company has been appointed.

There were no tangible assets of the company to be found, and as the Pacific Fire Insurance company is a mutual company organized under the laws of this state, the policy holders are liable and an assessment may be levied upon them to pay losses.

Pursuant to such law an order in the above entitled cause was made on the 17th day of October, 1908, by the superior court of the state of Washington for King county, levying an assessment of five times the amount of one annual premium upon each and every policy of record in the Pacific Fire Insurance company, and by such order the receiver of the company was directed to give notice of the levying of such assessment by publishing a notice to the policy holders of the company twice in the Argus, a paper of general circulation published in Seattle.

Pursuant to such order publication was made in said paper on the 24th and 31st of October, 1908.

You as a policy holder in the said company are liable in the sum of \$175 assessed against your policy and each and every policy of record in said company is assessed in proportion, and unless the said amount above named is paid to the undersigned, receiver of the said company, suit will be brought against you for the purpose of collecting the same.
