BARBERS TO CLOSE EARLY

NEW RULING EFFECTIVE AFTER JANUARY 25TH.

On Week Days Shops Will Close at 6, and Saturday Nights at 10—A Very Proper Move.

The early closing fever has raged in this city, the Barber Association being the latest organization to bow down to the precepts of the earlier closing. At a meeting of representatives of all barber shops in the city, held last evening at the Myers tenorial parlors, with President Myers in the chair, it was decided that in view of the fact that the merchants are closing earlier and find the practice one of benefit to everyone concerned, all shops would adopt earlier closing regulations. Not alone does the new ruling affect week days, but it extends to Saturday night as well, all shops agreeing to close at 10 o'clock instead of 11 as customary. On week days the curtains go down at 6 o'clock.

Commencing on the 25th of this month, the new hours become effective. The patrons of barber shops who make a habit of dropping in just before 11 o'clock on Saturday nights will have to mend their ways. As with the shoppers, so with patrons of barber shops; there will have to be a general readjustment of habits or the old rusty razor will have to do duty many a Sunday morning. There is no question but what the early closing hours are just and proper, notwithstanding that at first it will require a few "stings" to properly teach the patrons the truth of the statement.

SERVICES HELD IN THE CHURCH LARGELY ATTENDED
