EXPRESS TRAIN DITCHED.

Several Killed and Many Injured in a Midnight Collision.

Summer Hill, Pa., Jan. 23.—Three are dead and six injured, one probably fatally, as the result of a rear-end collision between two sections of the St. Louis express, westbound, on the Pennsylvania road near here, at midnight. The wreck was due to a fog. The three killed were asleep in their berths in the first section. The impact put out the light and confusion and panic followed.
