**Ordinance No. 405, Series 1909.**

An ordinance to license and regulate the sale of near beer, maltina and other malt beverages, except beer, ale and porter, within the city of La Grande.

Whereas a number of persons are engaged in the city of La Grande in the sale of near beer and other malt beverages; and

Whereas the public good requires some regulation of the sale of such near beer and other malt beverages, and of places where the same are sold; therefore

**The City of La Grande does ordain as follows:**

Section 1. No person or persons shall within the city of La Grande, directly or indirectly, by himself or by another, sell, barter, dispose of or deliver, or permit to be sold, bartered, disposed of or delivered for him or them or for his or their account or use, any near beer, maltina or other malt beverage, except beer, ale or porter, in any quantity, without first obtaining a license therefor as in this ordinance provided, and the recorder shall issue a license to any person or persons desiring to sell, barter, dispose of or deliver near beer or malt beverages within the city of La Grande when such a person or persons shall comply with the provisions of this ordinance, and in accordance with the terms of this ordinance only, and not otherwise; provided, that nothing in this ordinance contained shall be held to require any person or persons conducting or operating any brewery within the city of La Grande to pay a license for so doing, or shall be held to apply to any person engaged in conducting a bona fide drug store within the city of La Grande from selling malt beverages in the usual course of such drug business.

Sec. 2. Every person or persons who desires or proposes to sell, barter, dispose of or deliver near beer, maltina or other malt beverages, except beer, ale and porter in less quantity than one gallon, or to be drunk on the premises where sold, bartered or disposed of or delivered within the city of La Grande shall first pay to the treasurer of the city the sum of \$50.00 for each period of six months for a license so to do, and such license shall authorize him to sell such beverages in any quantity he may desire. No license shall be issued under this ordinance for a period of less than six months.

Sec. 3. Every applicant for a license under this ordinance shall, at least fifteen (15) days before he desires such license to issue, file with the city recorder his application therefor in writing, which application shall set forth the location of the applicant's place of business, the name or names of the applicants, the residence and occupation of applicant during the year next preceding the date of such application, and the names of at least three reputable citizens of the city of La Grande, as reference to the good character of the applicant, which application shall be accompanied by a good and sufficient bond, executed to the city of La Grande, in the penal sum of \$1000, with two or more sufficient resident sureties, conditioned that the said applicant will not give, sell or supply any such beverage to any minor, and will not give, sell or dispose of any intoxicating liquor upon the premises or in connection with the business for which such license is asked, which application and bond the recorder shall at the first regular meeting thereafter submit to the common council for action thereon, and if, after consideration and investigation of such application and applicant, bond and bondsmen, said common council shall be satisfied that it is proper and not contrary to public interest that such application be granted, said common council may, by order regularly made and entered, approve said bond and direct the recorder to issue a license as applied for, but no license shall be issued otherwise under this ordinance. In case of any violation of the conditions of the bond herein provided the licensee shall upon conviction before the city recorder, be fined not less than Fifty Dollars, nor more than One Hundred Fifty Dollars, or be imprisoned in the city jail not less than Twenty-Five days nor more than Seventy-Five days, and in addition to such fine and imprisonment shall forfeit his license, and no such fine or forfeiture shall in any manner release any bondsman from obligation on such bond.

Sec. 4. It shall be unlawful for any person engaged in selling near beer, maltina or other malt beverages, except beer, ale and porter, under the provisions of this ordinance, within the city of La Grande, to sell or dispose of any such beverage to any minor, nor to permit any minor to remain in or about the premises where such beverages are sold.

Sec. 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction before the recorder of the city of La Grande, be fined not less than Fifty Dollars nor more than One Hundred Fifty Dollars, or be imprisoned in the city jail not less than Twenty-Five days, nor more than Seventy-Five days, or shall be both fined and imprisoned, in the discretion of the recorder.

Sec. 6. That this ordinance shall be published in one issue of the La Grande Evening Observer, and its approval by the Mayor shall be in force and take effect on and after the 25th day of February, 1909.

Passed the common council on the 21st day of January, 1909, by eight members voting therefor.
