BACK FROM NEBRASKA

LOCAL LIGHT PLANT NOT SOLD AS REPORTED.

Consolidation of Fremont and Baker City Power Plants Has No Bearing on the G. R. E. Plant—Will Continue to Get Power as Heretofore, Regardless of Change.

The Grande Ronde Electric Light & Power company of this city has not been sold to the consolidated concern known as the Fremont Light & Power company, though contrary reports are prevalent. Manager Walter M. Pierce returned this morning from Fremont, Neb., and denies the report from Baker City that the local company had been made one of the consolidated concerns. The Baker City plant has been taken over by the combine, but as for the La Grande plant, there is no truth in the statement. Mr. Pierce was in Fremont when the changes took place, and comes back still managing the concern here.

The plans advanced by the Fremont people to form a combine of eastern Oregon companies, valued at \$2,000,000, the G. R. E. Co. to be one of the combine. Mr. Pierce was to be one of the combine, but the full extent of the value of his company. This plan fell through as far as the combine is concerned.

Baker Plant Sold. It is the Baker City concern that has been supplying the electric light from the Rock creek plant for the La Grande company of late. Now that company has sold out to the Fremont concern, which will continue to supply the power as usual. The contract with the original company was a 10-year affair, and it still stands that way.

Notwithstanding contrary reports, Mr. Pierce will still manage and own the plant in this city.
