SETS CASES FOR TRIAL

FEBRUARY TERM OF CIRCUIT COURT NEXT WEEK.

Several Cases of Much Interest to the Public—Friends of Law and Order Look Forward to the Findings of the Grand Jury Over Alleged Bootlegging Cases.

Several cases of importance and general interest will come up at the February term of circuit court, which sits next Monday. To arrange cases for the term Circuit Judge J. W. Knowles will hold a session of court Thursday afternoon at 1:30, and all attorneys having cases pending, will be given a chance to appear before the court with their requests at that time.

Grand Jury Monday.

Whenever a grand jury is empaneled, there is always deep interest and oftentimes apprehension, at what the body will do. This august body of bill-finders will be called Monday and from then on until the end of the term the wheels of justice will grind industriously.

Chief among the cases of import to come up during the coming term, will be Al Warren's suit against the George

Palmer Lumber company for damage money for personal injuries sustained some time ago while he was employed in the lumber yards at the mill. Another case of much interest is the one where Mrs. Rogers of North La Grande is suing the O. R. & N. over some property within the limits of the railroad yards. Then, too, there is the Joe Williams case.

What will be done with bootleggers by the grand jury is another phase of the coming term that is creating much discussion. Friends of law and order look forward to this term as one that will put a stop to the alleged flagrant disregard for the local option laws.

Grand Jury Dismissed.

The grand jury appointed at the last October term of the circuit court has been dismissed. It was the original intention to have this grand jury meet the early part of this week and return what true bill they might decide upon in order that these matters could be taken up immediately when the February term met, which will be next Monday. There apparently being no special work to investigate, Judge Knowles decided to dismiss the jury and will have the jury to be drawn next Monday to investigate whatever may come before it.
