Forestry Service to Experiment Further on Coyote-Proof Fence.

Wallowa, Feb. 5.—The council passed a fire limits ordinance a few weeks ago. At the last meeting a petition was presented asking that the ordinance be rescinded.

A preliminary report upon the experimental coyote-proof pasture that the forest service built at Billy Meadows, has been received and contains much interesting data. A copy may be had upon application to the Forestry Service, Washington, D. C. The government experiment at Billy Meadows will be carried on again next year and there will be some changes in number and grade of sheep which are grazed. J. F. Jardine, the engineer, will arrive March 15 and take active charge.

The Forest service is building a telephone line from the end of the Home Independent lines at Munsey's place on Prairie Creek to Ranger McClain's headquarters.

ANOTHER MILL LIKELY.

Hilgard Lumberman Over in Wallowa Looking for Location.

H. A. Shropshire, a prominent timberman of Hilgard, came to Wallowa Wednesday on a short business trip. It is reported on good authority, although he is very reticent, that Mr. Shropshire is looking for a suitable body of timber for mill operations and in case he can secure the timber he wants, he will install a mill with a capacity of 30,000 feet per day.—Wallowa Sun.

Caught Murderer.

Sheriff Ed Rand of Baker county, and Sheriff S. J. Courdin of Washington county, Idaho, arrived in the city today from Copperfield with A. C. Biggerstaff, who is wanted on the charge of murder, relates the Herald. The crime for which the prisoner is being taken back to Weiser, the county seat of Washington county, was committed about two months ago near Council. Biggerstaff has been employed by a man named Moore, who was about 50 years old. When it came time to settle for the work performed by the prisoner, there was a disagreement as to the amount of money due, and Biggerstaff beat his forehead over the head with a club, it is alleged. The assailant then got away and has just been apprehended. Moore was in a very serious condition, and lingered along for six weeks, when he died.
