## JURY GIVES OLIVER \$14

Roy T. Oliver was given judgment by the jury hearing his case against H. Eichenberger, appealed from the justice court. The trial lasted two days, the jury retiring late Saturday evening and Sunday reached an agreement. The sealed verdict was opened this morning by Circuit Judge Knowles and the parties in the contest were advised of the findings. While carrying out the decision of the lower court the jury reduced the judgment greatly. When the case was heard before Justice Stewart, Oliver was given judgment in the sum of \$120.45. When the recent jury reached a verdict, the sum involved had simmered down to \$14.40. The litigation followed, alleged non-payment for goods sold by Oliver to Eichenberger.
