HAZING WAS COSTLY FUN

University of Oregon, Feb. 7.—(Special.)—For violating the faculty rule against hazing, Linn Coovert, '12, has been suspended from the university during the semester. Five other freshmen, also implicated in the offense, were allowed to remain on probation because the rule had not yet been bulletined and they were ignorant of its existence. Curiously enough, they were hazing one of their own classmates, Nelson Gammans of Portland.

The alleged hazing was committed on the night of January 20, and was the culmination of a series of disputes which began almost as soon as the freshmen class organized. After a number of stormy meetings they decided to exclude outsiders from the class dance. Two members refused to obey. One was a girl, the vice-president of the class. The other student was Gammans. The university coeds were not fair enough to suit his aesthetic sense, so he took a pretty high school girl as his partner.

But freshmen at the University of Oregon brook no such infringements of their laws. On the Wednesday following, six of them delegated themselves as officers to bring the offender to justice. At the corner of Twelfth and Alder streets, scantily attired, he entertained them for about a half hour with the alluring steps of the Salsome dance. His high school partner did not accompany him on this occasion.

The rule that the faculty had previously passed was as follows: "Resolved, That any student who shall participate in the hazing of any other student, in whatever manner and with whatever object, shall be excluded from the privileges of the university." This rule was not bulletined and no official announcement of it had been made when the hazing was done. Coovert said that he knew the faculty disapproved of hazing and this was taken by them to mean that he knew of their prohibitive rule. When it was afterwards explained to him, he denied that he understood them to mean a specific rule against it; but the action had already been taken. His companions denied knowledge of the rule and were therefore allowed to remain on probation. They are Lyle Brown, George Roche, Charles Randall, Abe Blackman and Harry Fiegel. Coovert will go directly to the University of California, where he had already planned to complete his college year.

SPUD MARKET IMPROVED

GROWERS REALIZING ABOUT \$1 PER HUNDRED.

Grande Ronde Farmers Who Pitted Potato Crop Are Now Reaping Profitable Prices—Crop Small and Often Immature—Pitting Has Remedied All Faults.

Last year's potato crop has commenced to move this month, and the farmers who were keen and nervy enough last fall to pit their crops rather than sell them when the market was slow and prices low, are realizing at least \$1 per hundred this month.

The potato crop was light last season but in addition to that, buyers were slow in closing deals, fearing the crop was immature in many instances, due to the replanting frequently necessary. By pitting the potatoes for an extensive period, the "spuds" seem to acquire a post-season maturation, which gives them excellent flavor and good storing qualities.

Last week the market touched the dollar mark and farmers commenced to unload their crops immediately. The present week will see several shipments from different parts of the county.
