Billy Sunday made a whirlwind tour of Portland, the city which for years has been the home of Dr. Brougher, of the White Temple, where almost everything is to be expected from the pulpit, certainly did not have time to catch their breath from the time the evangelist began until he finished. Some idea may be reflected as to the manner in which he left his audience, as he took an automobile to catch a train bound for California.
