BUILD STEEL BRIDGES.

Baker County Will Build Three Structures in Near Future.

With an idea of making improvements capable of standing the wear Baker county's court has ordered three new steel bridges built in different parts of the county. Bids are now being received for this work and the plans and specifications are on file with the county clerk.

In building steel bridges the court has taken a step forward that will never be retraced. While the expense is greater than wood at first, the constant repair necessitated by wooden structures is overcome by installing the steel bridges, which in the end is a money saver to taxpayers. Very few counties use wooden bridges at the present time.

The estimated cost of the three bridges will be in the neighborhood of \$10,000, but when once erected there will be no further expense except to give each a coat of paint occasionally to prevent rust.
