KNIGHTS GO TO WALLOWA

Several Knights of Pythias of this city are in Enterprise today and tonight, and will either witness or take a part in the big convention program planned for Wallowa county knights this evening. It is in the nature of a competitive affair, especially in the drill work, and Deputy Sheriff Lindgren and County Superintendent E. E. Bragg will act as Judges of the drill. Chief Consul Commander J. F. Baker also went to the convention this morning. Enterprise is noted for hospitality and the local knights went away feeling positive they would be given royal entertainment.

Pythian Knights throughout the nation are celebrating today the 45th anniversary of the founding of their order. It was on February 19, 1864, Washington, in what was known as Temperance hall, that Washington lodge No. 1, Knights of Pythias, was organized. In the 45 years that have intervened the fraternity has grown until it is now rapidly approaching the million mark in membership, and, according to officials, that goal is not far distant. The order has followed the flag and now has lodges in Hawaii, Cuba, Porto Rico, the Philippines, Alaska and Panama.

The founder of the order was Justus to whom the thought first came of organizing a fraternal society, especially for the social advantage of the great army of clerks and employes in the several government departments in the city of Washington. This was in the midst of the civil war, and all surroundings seemed favorable to instituting such a body.

During the fall of 1863 Rathbone came into possession of a copy of John Banim's play of "Damon and Pythias," and this so impressed him with its adaptability for the ceremonial work of a fraternal society, that he at once commenced the preparation of a ritual for a body to be known as the "Knights of Pythias."
