BOOST ITEMS OF INTEREST

Portland, Ore., Feb. 22.—(Special correspondence.)—Seven stalwart young Swedes arrived in Portland last Thursday, direct from their far northern home. They all came from one village, and in a great many cases their sweethearts had preceded them. A prominent society belle of this city was heard to say that she wished she was a Swede, that they had a lot more fun than she and her friends.

The officers of the Portland Commercial club are taking time by the forelock in making the announcement that during the session of the legislature just closed not a single suggestion or request of any kind or character was put before Oregon law-makers by the club.

Positive promises are made that Eugene and Portland, the two cities at the extremes of the Willamette valley, are to be connected by trolley just as soon as men and money can do the work.

Some one remarked 19 days ago that "The people of Oregon are as nervous as a drove of black ants on a hot rock"—the legislature has since adjourned.

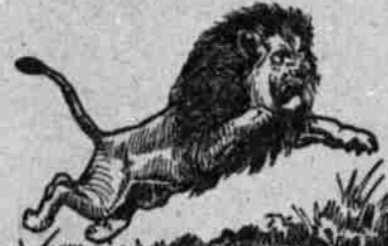
