IMPORTANT NEW LAWS

By grappling with the hands of the senate chamber clock Saturday night, the legislature was able to wind up its business to the satisfaction of the solons and for a period of two years again, the state capitol building will be deserted as far as the law-makers are concerned, unless special sessions are ordered. Considerable legislation of important bearing on eastern Oregon during the recent session, became state-wide issues. Among the laws to be passed by the Union-Wallowa delegations and by eastern Oregon joint delegations, follow:

- Bills Passed.**
- S. B. 7, Oliver—Appeal from justice court within 30 days.
 - S. B. 13, Nottingham—Voters absent from the state may register.
 - S. B. 15, Beach—Bank deposits not drawn for seven years to escheat to the state.
 - S. B. 31, Oliver—Fixing the salary of Union county recorder.
 - S. B. 34, Oliver—For publication of advance sheets of supreme court.
 - S. B. 47, Oliver—\$25,000 for eastern Oregon experiment farm.
 - S. B. 65, Cole—To abolish secret societies in public schools.
 - S. B. 82, Smith of Marlon—Providing for one Normal school near Portland and abolishing all others.
 - S. B. 114, Mult—Prohibit false rumors concerning the standing of banks.
 - S. B. 210, Kay—For county referendum on county measures.
 - S. B. 231, Oliver—Fixing the term of court in the Tenth judicial district.
 - H. B. 216, Carter—For appointment of county fruit inspectors.
 - H. B. 236, Philipot—Increasing annual apportionment of county school funds from \$50 to \$100 per district.
 - H. B. 227, Eastern Oregon delegation—Providing for a branch asylum in eastern Oregon.
 - H. B. 22, Barrett—Appropriating \$75,000 for a portage road at Celilo.
 - H. B. 23, Jaeger—Appropriating additional \$25,000 for Alaska-Yukon exposition.
 - S. B. 158, Oliver—Railroads need not file trip passes issued to regular employees.
 - S. B. 162, Bingham—For publication of delinquent tax lists at expense of delinquents and not at expense of the county.
 - S. B. 225, Johnson—Certified copy proof of a federal liquor license.
