At 8 o'clock this evening he will preside at a dinner attended by the Roosevelt and Taft families.

New Yorkers Form Escort.

New York, March 3.—A score of political organizations leave today for Washington to form a personal escort for President Roosevelt after he leaves the capitol after the inauguration of William H. Taft. Roosevelt will take a carriage at the capitol steps, be driven down Delaware avenue, where the organization will await him. A hollow square will be formed with Roosevelt in the center and, led by a band, the column will move to the railway. Those expected to be in the ranks are United States Senator Root, Chairman Woodruff of New York state republican committee and ex-Senator Chauncey M. Depew of New York.

BOOM IN SPOKANE.

Gigantic Real Estate Deals Consummated Since Yesterday.

Spokane, March 3.—Following the decision in the Spokane rate case favoring Spokane, gigantic real estate deals hanging fire for months, were suddenly closed and a big boom is expected. A 20 per cent raise in business property is predicted.

CITY SHOULD MEET HALF
