### BOOKS AND MAGAZINES.

The newest thing in the way of theatrical literature, which in this instance is fact and fiction combined, is "Bill Truetell." It is written by Geo. H. Brennan and illustrated by James Montgomery Flagg. The hero is a manager of the old school and in the days when "shoeing" management flourished he was a king among his brethren. "During that palmy period of the drama a manager possessed of a surplus over the amount of money required to move his attraction to the first stand, was regarded with distrust by the fraternity. Of such suspicion Bill was never the object."

To theatrical people "Bill Truetell" will be like a page from the past. But even keener will be the enjoyment of those who read the book knowing the stage only from "in front" for the book affords a glimpse of a life that is always mysterious and fascinating to the rest of us who only look on.

In "Ganton & Co.," the author holds up both the Chicago millionaire and the labor delegate to the limelight. The contrasting pictures of life among the stockyards workers and that of the pleasure seeking rich, make a story of unusual interest. The "old man," Ganton, has a son who becomes engaged to a girl whose father has been one of Ganton's chief enemies. The character studies of May Keating, the girl, and her sweetheart's father are vividly portrayed.

If one desires to smile and laugh and finally to bellow, he should read "The Letters of Jennie Allen to Her Friend, Mrs. Musgrove." This is what Jennie told her friend when writing about a proposal she had received: "Jen," sez he, "a man sozzling along without wife is like sewing without no under thread.
