## WESTON IS ON WAR PATH

Weston, Ore., March 5.—Weston people have no intention of complying with the order of the board of regents that all funds subscribed for the school be turned over to the state treasury. Instead the fund that has been raised will be expended at the direction of an executive committee and Ira M. Kemp, who has been named as trustee for the fund.

The view taken by Weston people is that the Normal school regents virtually ceased to exist some time ago. But prior to disbanding the regents notified the different Normal schools that if they continued in operation they would have to do so upon local responsibility. After having made such an announcement as this the action of the board in asking that locally raised money be turned over to the state is regarded as highly inconsistent.

Furthermore, it is believed that the regents want to secure control of the subscription money partly for the purpose of using it to pay off a back indebtedness. When the Normal schools were dropped by the state through the failure of the legislature to provide funds for maintenance, considerable money was due teachers and others. This has never been paid nor has the state made any provision for paying the claims.

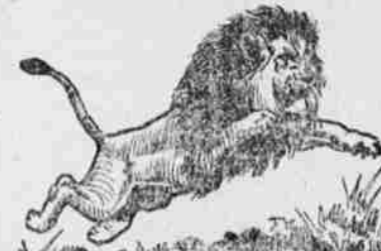
That the money which has been subscribed for the Weston school must be used for defraying the expenses of the school from now until June is the decision of the committee in charge. This committee will not turn the money over to the state treasurer and has so notified the regents.

At recent meetings the Weston and Athena lodges of the Farmers' cooperative union passed resolutions calling upon the legislature to provide funds for the support of the Weston school until the close of the present year.
