Seattle, March 8.—The Pacific Coast Saengerbund completed arrangements for the building of a magnificent specimen of the old Viking ship of the early ninth century, and the model will be executed from the identical lines of the famous old Viking ship unearthed in 1890, at Trondhem, Norway. The vessel is now well under way at the town of Bother, Wash., and will be sailed down Lake Washington to the grounds of the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific exposition on August 13, which day has been set aside as Norway day by the exposition management.
