SLIGHT WRECK AT HURON

Though several freight cars of No. 56 were in the ditch yesterday at Huron, traffic on the main line was not stalled. This is one of the remarkable freaks of railroading. When the west-bound freight, No. 56, was pulling on a siding, one car was derailed by a broken flange and before the slowly moving train could be stopped, several other cars went the same way. The wrecker was sent out from La Grande but the extreme haste generally required of the wrecking crew was not really necessary for trains could pass the wreck on the main line. No one was hurt by the derailment.

NEW N. P. TRAIN.

Pendleton Will Have Better Service to North Bank Hereafter.

The object sought by the Commercial association several months ago, but which was considered practically hopeless, will soon be a reality according to an announcement made yesterday afternoon by a party of Northern Pacific officials who visited Pendleton for a few hours, says the Tribune. A new passenger train from this city to Pasco, connecting with the North Bank and the main line of the Northern Pacific, will be started in a few days.

The officials had little to say regarding the object of the special service. That it will be highly appreciated by the people of this city is sure. The Commercial association took the matter up some time ago, and it has also been discussed in the city council.

The new schedule which makes the direct connections with the trains on the main line, both to the south, to Spokane, and to Portland, is as follows: Leave Pasco 6:30 a. m., and arrive at Pendleton 9:30 a. m.; leave Pendleton at 6:15 p. m. and arrive at Pasco at 9 p. m.
