DENY CHARGES. One of Three at Pendleton Seems to Have Misstated.

Pendleton, March 11.—That they can show bills and receipts for shoes, clothing and other things which they purchased during the time they are charged with having stolen everything in that line that they needed, are the statements made by Charles Ely, transcontinental freight inspector, and William Edwards, former truckman in the O. R. & N. freight warehouse. On the witness stand yesterday Charles Dickens declared that neither of the men could show where they had ever bought a pair of shoes since the two men had been working in the warehouse.

Both men today declare they can show bills at Bond Brothers where they purchased their shoes and that they can show where Ely purchased shoes there regularly during the time he has been in the city. Edwards says he bought his coal from Ben Burroughs, despite the fact that Dickens tried to force stolen coal upon him. He also maintains that he can show receipts from the Walters' mill for purchases of wheat for chicken feed which he is accused by Dickens of having stolen.
