WITHYCOMBE PRAISES O A C

HOPES UNION COUNTY WILL REFRAIN FROM SIGNING

Growing Institution Should Be Let Alone—Southern Oregon People Are Signing Referendum.

"O. A. C. is a great institution, growing rapidly, and we trust that the people of this section of our state will not entertain the referendum petition which has been circulating among the southern Oregon people," said Superintendent Robert Withycombe of the Union experiment station, yesterday, on his return from Corvallis. Mr. Withycombe, it will be remembered, recently assumed the superintendency of the Union station, and spent some time in Corvallis conferring with officials. Like every other loyal-hearted citizen of Union county, he realizes that it would be folly to invoke the referendum on a school which fills so important a place in the education of Oregon's young. The state suffered considerable damage in the east when a similar measure was aimed at the State university at Eugene, and to repeat the attempt on another school of the state would leave a still worse impression among those who aim to come west with a family of children needing an education.

BURNETT TO BE PRESENT

WASCO BANKER WILL BE READY TO LEND AID

Man Who Owns 1600 Acres of Grande Ronde Valley Land, is Here and Will Subscribe Big Portion.

Wilson Burnett, the leading banker of Wasco, Sherman county, is in the city for the purpose of attending the mass meeting of irrigationists tomorrow morning. Mr. Burnett has 1600 acres of land in Union county, and will throw most of it under the proposed scheme. "I left my business in Wasco to attend this extremely important meeting," said the financier today. "In our county we would gobble up such a proposition so quickly that you could not 'see us for the dust,' vehemently explained the banker in response to what he thought of the local scheme. Others are here from various parts of the northwest, and will be here tomorrow to have a voice in the important meeting.
