IRRIGATE THE EAGLE VALLEY

FOUR THOUSAND ACRES TO BE THOROUGHLY WATERED.

What Was Formerly Part of Union County is to Be Watered by Yakima Capitalists, is the Report.

An irrigation scheme which will now cover 4000 acres of fine fruit land in the Eagle valley, formerly a portion of Union county, is now being promoted by a firm of Yakima land men, and its success is said to be assured. Although no formal announcement of the company's plans have as yet been made, it has been stated that the concern had secured a sufficient water right, from the waters of Eagle creek, to thoroughly cover the 4000 acres which it is proposed to reclaim, having paid \$25,000 for the right.

The water will be brought from the creek out in a special ditch across the east slope of the valley, where it will be distributed.

The land to be watered has never before been irrigated and up to the present has simply been used for range purposes, but on account of its richness and its particularly favorable location, it is said to include some of the finest orchard land in the whole of the valley.

The proprietors of the irrigation scheme expect to bring several families into the valley in the course of the next year, and will divide the tract up into small holdings.

ROUND THE ROUND HOUSE.

Three thousand tons of coal are already in the storage bunkers. Most of that amount was unloaded by the patent dump car method, but a portion comes in box cars and Dago perspiration flows freely during the unloading. More will be stored here.

Engine No. 190 will come out of the Albina shops soon equipped with the steam pipe apparatus which will feed the dynamo engine on the electrically lighted dining cars that are soon to go into service on the O. R. & N.

All passenger engines in the local round house have been ordered equipped with a 1 1/2-inch steam pipe from the boiler back to connect with a small engine on the dining cars that will operate the dynamo. The task is no small one.

The work trains wanted for Wal-lowa county track improvement, will go out next week. They were to have started two weeks ago, but such action was deferred.
