**GRAVEL ROADS AND STREETS**

**ELGIN WILL MEET ITS FARMERS WITH GOOD STREETS.**

City to Build to City Limits and Farmers Will Continue the Good Work—Other Elgin News Items.

Elgin, March 25.—(Special.)—The Commercial club of Elgin, at a very interesting meeting last night, agreed to meet the country folk at the city's limit with graveled streets. The surrounding people have already expressed their interest in the matter and work will be commenced at once, graveled streets and surrounding country roads.

The movement is hailed with delight from every hand.

**Model Food Factories.** Food Commissioner Barnard of Indiana, is rejoicing in the successful passage and enactment of his model sanitation bill for food factories, which he and his associates, as a committee of the Mackinac conference of last summer, drafted for submission in the several states. Manufacturers, even who are favorably disposed toward sanitation of their factories, regard it as especially rigorous and annoying, but Mr. Barnard is charmed. In a letter to a supporter in this vicinity, he says:

It is the culmination of the efforts of the consumers and food officials of this country in their crusade for pure food, and in my opinion is the most satisfactory food legislation enacted in this country since the passage of the federal food law. The provisions are very stringent. I call your attention to sections 2, 5, 7, 6 and 8 as requiring conditions which have hitherto been rarely obtained in food-producing establishments. The measure is before the legislature of many of our states, and the present indications are that it will become the law of a number of states before the close of the legislative sessions.

Section 2 prescribes that floors, sidewalks, ceilings, furniture, receptacles, implements and machinery of every establishment or place where food is manufactured, packed, stored, sold or distributed, and all cars, trucks and vehicles used in the transportation of food products, shall at no time be kept in an unclean, unhealthy and unsanitary condition, and for the purpose of this act, unclean, unhealthful and unsanitary conditions shall be deemed to exist if food in the process of manufacture, preparation, packing, storing, sale, distribution or transportation is not securely protected from flies, dust, dirt and as far as may be necessary, by all reasonable means from all other foreign or injurious contamination and if the refuse, dirt and the waste products subject to decomposition and fermentation incident to the manufacture, preparation, packing, storing, selling, distributing and transporting of food are not removed daily; and if all trucks, trays, boxes, baskets, buckets and other receptacles, chutes, platforms, racks, tables, shelves and all other utensils and machinery used in moving, handling, cutting, chopping, mixing, canning and all other processes are not thoroughly cleaned daily, and if the clothing of operatives, employes, clerks or other persons therein employed is unclean.
