## LA GRANDE STANDS LOYAL TO NATION-WIDE MOVEMENT

In August, 1905, the Birthplace Farm of Abraham Lincoln, consisting of 110 acres located about 50 miles from Louisville, Kentucky, was put up at public auction to be sold for unpaid taxes. It is a fact that all but one of the bidders who appeared

It is primarily the same motive that actuates La Grande people to give at least small amounts to the furtherance of plans for the proper commemoration of Lincoln's memory.
