ments are now under way for a fight between Jim Jeffries and Jack Johnson the fight to take place in Omaha for a purse of \$100,000. James Coffin and Martin Brady of Fresno, Cal., are engineering the contract portion of the deal, and Jabez Cross, of Omaha, is attending to the Omaha end, which includes the passage of a bill through the legislature permitting boxing in the State. The Californians arrived in Omaha today to close the deal, if the bill passes the legislature. Because of the central location of Omaha the promoters believe the largest fight crowd ever gathered can be brought here if the laws will permit the exhibition. As planned now the contract will call for a forty-round boxing contest.
