MUST BE MENTIONED ELECTION

We never have had councils that have been able to turn off as much business as the present, however, since the new charter requiring two meetings a month, and night sessions will be fewer than in the past.

Among the ordinances passed last evening was one prohibiting boys under 18 years of age from frequenting pool rooms; another prescribing the duties of chief of police; another authorizing a contract to be made with Engineer Pickler for \$1,400 to make permanent survey on Beaver creek water project.

Ordinances were introduced to prohibit ball playing on the streets within the fire limits. A petition containing the names of over 300 names asking that pool rooms be abolished also base ball and theatres on Sunday. The Petition was signed by a great many prominent citizens and being referred to the police and fire petition it will be considered and reported upon at the next meeting.

The committee reported that the county stood ready to meet the city half way on improving the court house grounds by building cement walks, setting out lawns and trees.

Mayor Hall stated that he had received a communication from the American Light and Water Company, who have the contract to put in the Beaver creek project, that their attorneys informed them that it would be necessary to resubmit the entire new charter just as it was only that it should have been initiated by petition instead of by the council and that 60 days notice must be given, as before.

ENORMOUS CASTING

A lintel to be used in the Lottes brick is being casted at the La Grande Iron Works shop that sets a new mark in foundry achievements for size and weight. The pattern is almost ready and measures 21 feet in length and when casted the affair will weigh between 2800 and 3000 pounds. This is really a remarkable production for a foundry of the capacity which the one in this city has other castings have been turned out from there that approach this lintel in weight but none that come near it for dimensions.
